2013-2017: Project addressing the impact of fuel poverty on people experiencing mental distress



Cold Homes and Poor Health

Fuel Poverty is estimated to affect as many as **4 million UK households** (NEA 2017)



In 2015/16 there were 24,300 excess winter deaths; 15% more in winter months (ONS 2016)

Estimated that cold homes cost NHS in excess of £1.36 billion annually (Koksharov 2007)

Psychological symptoms, malnutrition, social isolation (Marmot Review 2011) Studies indicate **mental** wellbeing increases after improvements (Eadson 2014, Gilbertson & Green 2008)
